How Does It Work?

It's simple.

All your club needs to do is show us how you meet at least two of the five criteria below throughout Season 2024 to be eligible for funding.

Register your club below, get involved throughout the season, and a team of TAC road safety experts and personnel from AFL Victoria will review your application in late August.

We're judging on how your club is able to address and report on the below criteria

2024 Criteria

To be eligible for funding, you must apply by August 25th, 2024, and address (via smartygrants) at least **two** of the **five** criteria listed below:

- 1. How well did the club put in place initiatives to raise awareness of the TAC's priority message for 2024: Speeding?
- 2. How well did the club amplify and support other TAC road safety campaigns and key messages in the following five areas: Drink Driving, Drowsy Driving, Distractions, Vehicle Safety, Young Drivers? (See key messages section for further guidance).
- 3. What initiatives did the club have in place to discourage participants from drink / drug driving at their club matches and events?
- 4. How well did the club engage their community in Road Safety Round?
