Welcome to the 2024 TAC Club Rewards Program

The TAC Club Rewards program is for community football clubs just like yours, and encourages ongoing participation to help us eliminate deaths and serious injuries on our roads. It takes all of us working together to achieve this.

So as the heart of each community, we're asking football netball clubs to lead this movement, by rewarding the ones who are passionate about our mission and demonstrate that commitment with up to \$10,000 worth of funding.

We'll promote your club and its stories, and in turn, together we'll encourage others to play their part in making Victorian roads a safer place for all of us.

How Does It Work?

It's simple.

All your club needs to do is show us how you meet **at least two of the five criteria** below throughout Season 2024 to be eligible for funding.

Register your club below, get involved throughout the season, and a team of TAC road safety experts and personnel from AFL Victoria will review your application in late August.

We're judging on how your club is able to address and report on the below criteria

2024 Criteria

To be eligible for funding, you must apply by August 25th, 2024, and address (via smartygrants) at least **two** of the **five** criteria listed below:

1. How well did the club put in place initiatives to raise awareness of the TAC's priority message for 2024: Speeding?

2. How well did the club amplify and support other TAC road safety campaigns and key messages in the following five areas: Drink Driving, Drowsy Driving, Distractions, Vehicle Safety, Young Drivers? (See key messages section for further guidance).

3. What initiatives did the club have in place to discourage participants from drink / drug driving at their club matches and events?

4. How well did the club engage their community in Road Safety Round?

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5. Did a high percentage of club members complete the TAC's 2024 road safety surveys?

Once you have submitted this first initial application form, you will be emailed an acquittal form where you will be able to submit your club's supporting evidence around each criterion as activities are completed and save as you go.

Funding information

Examples of what may be funded:

- Equipment – footballs for new teams; water bottles; training equipment including cones, tackle bags etc.
- Program delivery – coach education programs; programs which help connect local schools to your club; programs which address particular areas of need within your club ie mental health, attracting new participants

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- Apparel –ie. jumpers for new teams (with particular focus on junior, female teams)

Examples of what will not be funded:

- Player payments

For example. 'Put funding towards our junior club to purchase new playing jumpers and implement learner driver safety education sessions. We will buy training equipment to set up an extra women's team in 2024. We will upgrade our club scoreboard.'
